

Did you know that it's not just cats and dogs that need a health check, rabbits need one too. Unfortunately, it is not common for newly acquired pet rabbits to visit the vets for advice. We are inviting rabbit owners to a free consultation with a veterinary nurse, whether your rabbit is young or an adult. The nurse will give you advice on the following five welfare needs:

- 1. Environment
- 2. Diet
- 3. Behaviour
- 4. Companionship
- 5. Health



As well as advice, your rabbit will receive a thorough check over to help identify any potential health problems. This clinic will also give the opportunity for the nurse to show you how to perform a simple health check (BUNNY MOT) at home and educate you about the potential signs of poor health or behaviour problems.
